Important Uniform Guidelines for CAST Tech

Students may wear black or khaki bottoms, i.e. pants, shorts, skirts. Students have the following options for shirts:

- Any CAST Tech spirit shirt.
- Any college or university t-shirt (Start thinking about your future!)
- Long- and short-sleeved blouses and shirts with collars; solid color options include white, orange, gray or black (Note: orange and gray are the school colors for CAST Tech)



Not appropriate for school

- Yoga pants, leggings, sweatpants, basketball shorts, crop tops, tank tops, slides, flip flops, items with inappropriate language/sexual or drug references (even if implied)
